- Bring X-ray films or CDs of scans not completed by CentraCare.
- Bring a list of questions you would like to ask during your visit.
- A family member or supportive friend may accompany you if you'd like.
- If it has been more than 6 months, please complete a dental examination and cleaning. If your dentist recommends major dental work, please first discuss it with your oncology provider.

Prescription Refills: Contact your pharmacy for refills and if needed, they contact us.

Speaking to an Oncology Nurse: Call **320-229-4989**. Our nurse line is staffed Mon.-Fri. 8 a.m.– 4:30 p.m. Calls after 4 p.m. are returned the next business day.

Internet Access: For your comfort and convenience, Wi-Fi is available in our lobby.

MyChart: Register for MyChart at www.centracare.com/mychart and you can communicate with your doctor, request prescription refills, manage your appointments, securely access your medical information such as test results and more.
