It was 15 years ago that St. Cloud Hospital broke ground for the Gorecki Guest House. The Gorecki Guest House, located across the street from St. Cloud Hospital, offers affordable, temporary housing to families and patients receiving medical care in the St. Cloud community. The house was funded completely with private gifts, including

a leadership gift from Benedict and Dorothy Gorecki and featured 12 guest rooms with private baths and other amenities when it opened in June 2009.

Today, St. Cloud Hospital-Gorecki Guest House has 28 private rooms and has served more than 40,000 guests from every county in Minnesota, 49 states and 14 countries.


Book of Life embodies spirit of loved ones
