Effective August 17<sup>th</sup>, Mayo will be making the following test obsolete:

## CORTISOL/CORTISONE, FREE, RANDOM, URINE, MAYO CODE COCRU (LABCODE1131)

The recommended alternative test will be:

CORTISOL/CORTISONE, FREE, RANDOM, URINE, MAYO CODE CCFR

Minimum specimen requirements and temperature storage will change to the following:

## Specimen Requirements:

**Supplies:** Plastic, 10-mL urine tube (T068)

Container/Tube: Clean, plastic aliquot container with no metal cap or glued insert

Preferred: Refrigerated

Specimen Volume: 10 mL

**Collection Instructions:** Collect a random urine specimen

Minimum Volume: 5 mL

## Specimen Stability Information:

| Specimen Type | Temperature              | Time     |
|---------------|--------------------------|----------|
| Urine         | Refrigerated (preferred) | 14 days  |
|               | Ambient                  | 72 hours |
|               | Frozen                   | 28 days  |
