SUBJECT: Mayo Clinic aliquot tube changes effective 8/1/2022

On Aug. 1, Mayo Clinic Laboratories will transition to new clear and amber 5 mL aliquot tubes due to a recent change in the manufacturing process. The new tube is slightly smaller than the current tube and is not compatible with existing 5 mL aliquot tube caps.

**Action requested:** Mayo Clinic Laboratories strongly recommends that your organization permanently discard any old clear and amber 5 mL aliquot tubes and caps to prevent the mixing of the old and new supplies. By doing so, you will help prevent specimen leakage and ensure specimen integrity.

## **Next steps:**

- Replacement aliquot tubes will be automatically shipped to you in mid-July.
- 2. Replace all existing aliquot tubes with the new product. Please discard any old aliquot tubes and caps no later than Aug. 1.
- 3. Begin using the new tubes immediately.

## Ordering new clear and amber 5 mL aliquot tubes:

In mid-July, the new tubes will be orderable through the supply catalog and all standing orders will be updated to reflect the new supply items:

T914 – Sarstedt 5 mL Aliquot Tube

T915 – Sarstedt 5 mL Aliquot Tube (Amber)

At that time, supply items T465 (clear aliquot tube) and T192 (amber-frosted aliquot tube) will be obsoleted.
